 May 27, 2026**

1. Call to Order

- a. Mayor Tracy Mix called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m.; also via Zoom in Toledo, Oregon and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call

- a. City Recorder Johnson took roll call and determined a quorum is present.

- b. Staff Present: City Manager Rich Huebner, City Attorney Souvanny Miller, Planning Assistant Arlene Inukai and City Recorder Paul Johnson

3. Decision Items

- a. **Resolution No. 1608 Adopting Temporary Fireworks Vendor Policies**
 - i. City Manager Rich Huebner presented Resolution No. 1608, which had been initially introduced at the prior week's meeting. He summarized two amendments incorporated since the original draft. First, the language in Section 3 was corrected to read "3 applicants" rather than "3 applications," reflecting the council's intent to limit the number of vendors rather than the number of submissions. Second, at the recommendation of Planning Technician Arlene Inukai, Section 2 was amended to expand the eligible siting zones for temporary fireworks vendors from "commercial zone" to "commercial or light industrial zone," in recognition that several locations likely to be sought by vendors are zoned light industrial rather than commercial.
 - ii. No public comment was submitted for this item. The council proceeded directly to a vote.

- iii. **Motion** to adopt Resolution No. 1608 as amended was made by Councilor Keating and seconded by Councilor Chambers. The motion carried 5-0.

b. Nomination and Election of the City Council President


- i. City Manager Huebner advised the council that Council President Silvia had submitted his resignation from the council, effective the prior Tuesday, and that the council was therefore required to elect a new council president from among its current membership.
- ii. Two nominations were put forward: Councilors Keating self-nominated, having previously considered the role and noting that his availability had improved since earlier opportunities had arisen. Councilor Keating also indicated that, upon seeing support for Councilor Chambers, he was fully prepared to support Councilor Chambers instead.
- iii. Councilor Chambers was nominated by Councilor Keating. Councilor Burns, after joining the meeting remotely and being briefed on the nominations, asked both nominees about their availability and capacity before casting her vote.
- iv. The council voted by verbally stating their preference in turn. Both nominees acknowledged that they could not match the level of contribution made by the outgoing Council President Silvia, but each expressed willingness to serve in the role if selected by their colleagues.
- v. The final tally resulted in Councilor Chambers receiving four votes and Councilor Keating receiving two votes. Councilor Eric Chambers was accordingly elected as the new City Council President.


