

June 27, 2024 City Charter Review Committee Meeting

Meeting minutes

Call to Order

The City Charter Review Committee meeting was called to order. The session opened with a brief discussion about procedural requirements, noting that organizations need to register with the state.

Continue review of the Toledo City Charter

The committee discussed that this would be their final meeting for the charter review process. Committee members noted that they had thoroughly examined the entire charter, reviewing every section and word with the assistance of two attorneys.

Councilor Frank Silvia reported that the committee had not left any aspect of the charter unexamined during their comprehensive review process. He emphasized that the committee's work would benefit the citizens of Toledo.

The committee discussed that the revised charter would be presented to the City Council at their July 17, 2024 meeting. It was mentioned that the committee had reworked the entire charter document.

Members expressed satisfaction with the thoroughness of their review process and confidence that the revised charter would serve the community well. They noted that in updating the charter, they had been careful to maintain provisions important to the community while modernizing the document.

New business

There was a brief mention that tomorrow would be the committee's final day, marking the conclusion of the charter review process. No other new business was introduced.
